Gas companies have been given the power to go ahead with gas field development here. The NSW government gave them Exploration licenses on our lands. There was no public information, or consultation.

The Coal Seam Gas (CSG) under our feet would require Unconventional Methods to extract it. This involves wells at about 750m intervals, with compressors that gas off chemicals into the air. Each well pulls up large amounts of salt water contaminated by chemicals from the coal seam, and potentially, from fracking. Gas wells are noisy, on cleared 70 x70m pads that can be 200m from a house. Large holding ponds for waste water are at risk of overflowing toxic chemicals during high rain. In the US, cattle have died, or had stillborn and malformed calves. Land values go down.

Imagine what a grid of wells, compressor stations, pipelines, roads and toxic 'holding ponds' will do to your property and community.

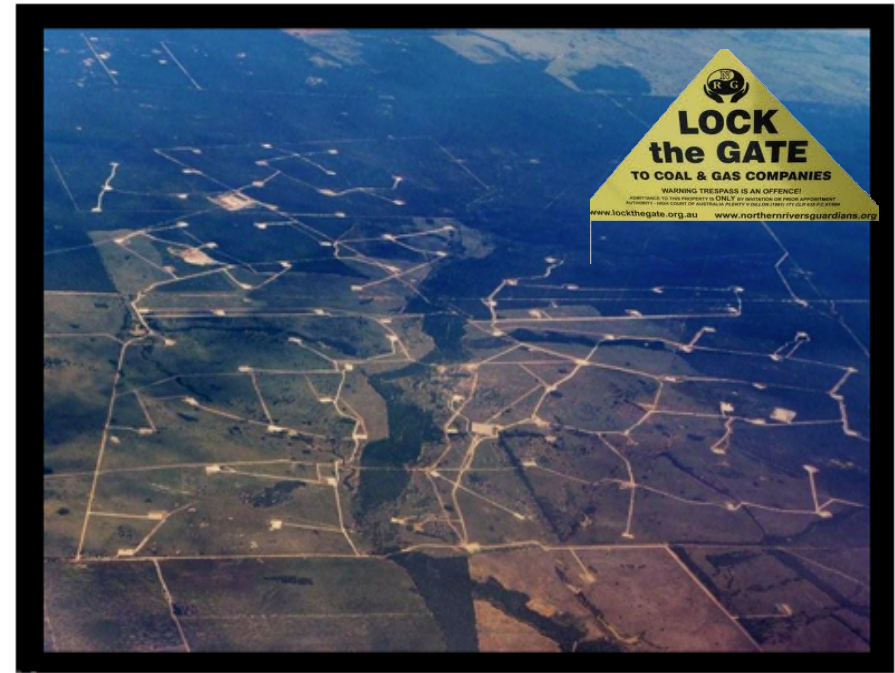
